## What are we learning this half term?

## **Composition**

This half term, we will be inspired by the book 'Coming to England'. We are going to be focusing on writing a range of adverbial phrases and writing subordination. In genre, your children will be creating their own poem.



# **Maths**







Our first topic in maths will be geometry where we will be investigating different shapes and their properties. Following this will then be time and statistics

## **Topic**

This half term, we will be studying geography. Your children will be learning about the



local environment. They will be developing their locational knowledge and their human and physical geography skills.

#### Art

In art we are going to be making Roman mosaics and creating art work by using textiles and creating a collage.



#### Science

In science, our topic will be electricity. We are going to explore electrical appliances and recognise conductors and insulators. Your children will carry out a scientific investigation into how to construct an electrical circuit.
