In maths we will be identifying 1 and 2 objects and developing our understanding of numbers in songs and rhymes.

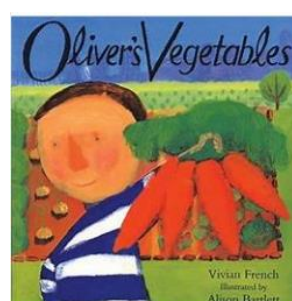
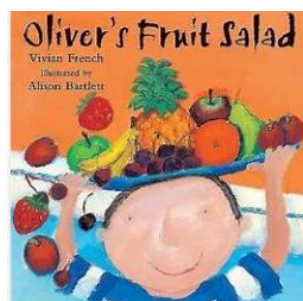
We will be introducing comparison language such as 'bigger', 'smaller'.
