What are we learning this half term?

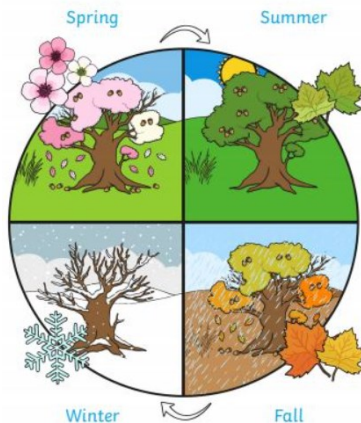
In Year 1, this half term, our topic work concentrates on weather around the world. We will recap our previous learning on the countries of the UK and look at describing the weather in each place.

In Science, we will be looking at seasonal changes. We will be learning all about the 4 seasons and we will investigate how trees and the temperature change throughout the year.

In our Art lessons, we will also be studying the work of Georgia O'Keeffe and creating art work of Spring flowers.

In English, we will look at the story STORM by the author Sam Usher and Tree by Britta Teckentrup. During the term, we will be writing setting descriptions that include expanded noun phrases. We will also be writing our own poems about the seasons.

In maths, we will focus on measurement. We will begin by measuring length and height. Later in the term we will measure weight and volume.

Home Learning
