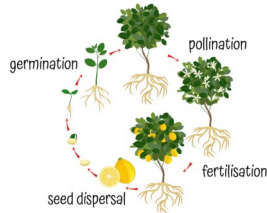


Year 3 Newsletter

Summer Term 1

What are we learning this half term?

In Year 3 this half term our topic work will continue looking at rivers from source to sea. We will focus on the River Nile in Egypt, before comparing it with our local river, the River Trent.



In Science, we will be exploring plants. We will be focusing on the role of the flower of a plant.

We will be studying William Morris and our art skill focus will be printmaking. Your children will create their own wallpaper.

In English, we are focusing on expanded noun phrases and contractions. We will be writing character descriptions.

In maths, we will focus on length and measurement and fractions.



New Vocabulary!

Topic: river source mouth delta tributary meander estuary valley evaporation condensation precipitation
Science: petal roots leaves stem bulb pollination fertilisation light seed dispersal water

Home Learning

At home, the children are still expected to read their school book, ideally at least 5 times weekly. This needs to be recorded in their home school diary.
